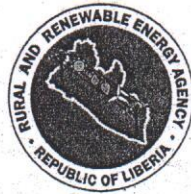

**Subject: Facilitation of Stakeholders' and Public Consultations for the Kaiha 2 Hydropower Project in Lofa County.**

I present my compliments and wish to inform you that The Rural and Renewable Energy Agency (RREA) is planning a mini hydropower project on the Kaiha River in Kolahun District, Lofa County. The project, referred to as Kaiha 2 is intended to provide affordable electricity supply to parts of Foya, Kolahun and Voinjama districts.

According to the Environmental Protection and Management Law of Liberia, the proposed hydropower plant and associated transmission lines fall under the 'Energy Industry' category, and as such are required to undergo an Environmental and Social Impact Assessment (ESIA). Therefore, in compliance with the Environmental Protection and Management Law of Liberia, RREA is conducting an ESIA and has contracted the services of Earthtime and Multiconsult to prepare the Environmental and Social Impact Assessment (ESIA) and Resettlement Action Plan (RAP) for the Kaiha 2 Hydropower Project.

A team of environmental and social experts will be in Lofa County between March 14 and March 18 to conduct consultations with the various villages and towns as well as site visits as part of the ESIA. The team will also consult with the various county officials, district commissioners, community leaders, and town chiefs.

In view of the foregoing, we are kindly requesting your support during the consultation process. We will appreciate very highly if you communicate your concerns with the team as well as facilitate the consultation process.
